"The Satanic Temple" has been in court many times, and there it has described its organizational framework in multiple confusing and outright contradictory ways.

In 2012, Cevin Soling and Doug Misicko had started a prank documentary film project under Soling's corporation "Spectacle Films Inc." meant to be about "the "nicest Satanic Cult in the world" and probably just intended to jam up public schools with religious liberty claims.

Instead, it caught on sincerely leading Misicko and Soling in 2014 to create the for-profit "United Federation of Churches LLC" and make intellectual property claims over their joke religious movement. They created a nonprofit later that year called "Reason Alliance Ltd." which they treated as interchangeable with the forprofit. Then more corps came, still owned by one or both men. One ("The Satanic Temple [Inc.]") is a tax-exempt church.

The treasurer and sole governing officer of tax-exempt church "The Satanic Temple"
Doug Misicko a.k.a. "Lucien
Greaves" said in depositions for
Cave v. Thurston in 2020,
"There is a tax exempt religious organization of The Satanic
Temple; but it can also engage in for-profit commerce, a online
Web store or whatever else."

Misicko stated that money from the general fund went to pay his rent and help him "just stay afloat" but without any set protocol — or oversight, transparency, or accountability.

Misicko — again, treasurer of the tax-exempt church responsible for at minimum hundreds of thousands of dollars — also said he had no idea how much Cevin Soling, his co-owner in other projects, was paying himself with it.

TST has never given an accounting for how much the owners pay themselves, or how much money they spend suing critics who talk about it, now including at least four lawsuits.
